Anti-Transferrin (human) in rabbit, IgG fraction

Description

Polysciences' anti-Transferrin (human) in rabbit, IgG Fraction, reacts with transferrin from human serum. Strong cross-reactivity will occur with mammalian forms of this protein. This reagent is suitable for immunoblotting (western or dot blot), ELISA, immunoprecipitation, conjugation and most immunological methods requiring high titer and specificity.

Buffer: 0.02 M Potassium Phosphate, 0.15 M Sodium Chloride (pH 7.2)

Preservative: 0.01% (w/v) Sodium Azide Immunogen: Transferrin (Human Serum)

Recommended Dilution(s)

This product has been assayed against 1.0µg of Transferrin (Human Serum) in a standard sandwich ELISA using Peroxidase conjugated Affinity Purified anti-Rabbit IgG [H&L] (Goat) and ABTS (2,2'-azino-bis-[3-ethylbenthiazoline-6-sulfonic acid]) as a substrate for 30 minutes at room temperature. A working dilution of 1:5,000 to 1:6,500 of the reconstituted concentration is suggested for this product. The researcher should determine optimal titers for other applications.

Purity and Specificity

This product is an IgG fraction antibody purified from monospecific antiserum by a multi-step process which includes delipidation, salt fractionation and ion exchange chromatography followed by extensive dialysis against the buffer stated above. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Rabbit Serum, as well as purified and partially purified Transferrin (Human Serum). Cross reactivity against Transferrin from other tissue and species may occur, but have not been specifically determined.

Storage and Stability

Store at 4°C prior to restoration. Restore with 0.5ml of deionized water (or equivalent). Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4°C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use. For extended storage, aliquot contents and freeze at -20°C or below. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Expiration date is one (1) year from date of restoration.

This product is for research use only and is not intended for use in humans or for in vitro diagnostic use.
